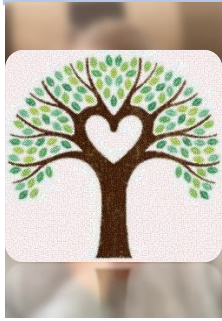

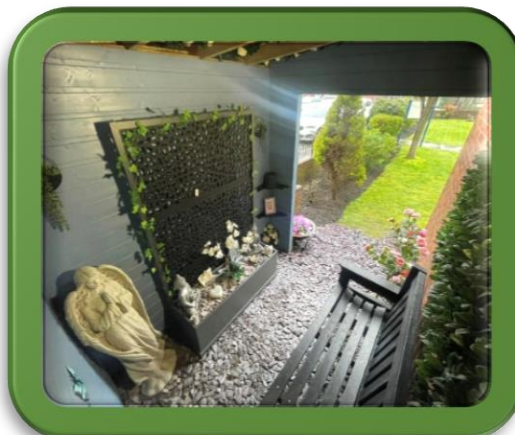

The residents enjoyed an afternoon of country music with Paddy. His set list included country classics and 60's hits.



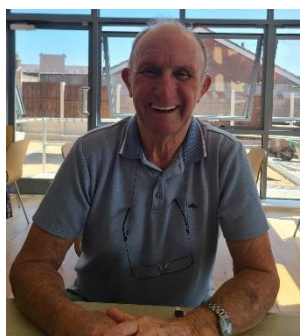
TRIP TO CUPPACINO BISTRO 14TH JUNE
