We hope this will be fully repaired early July time and we apologise for any inconvenience caused.



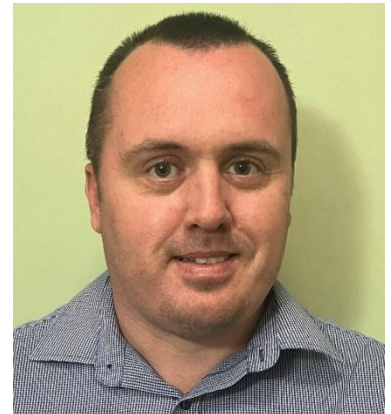
A big happy retirement to our accountant Julie!!
